

Prof. Abdullah S. Al Nagrash

He graduated from Irbid Senior High School scientific branch with a specialization in Mathematics in 1968. He joined the faculty of Commerce and Economics at The University of Jordan and majored in General Administration and Political Science and graduated in 1972. He worked at The Arab National Union as Secretary General of the Political Section until the year 1974. He then joined the tax department as an Assessor and Controller. He joined the United Nations Office of Development and National Planning in 1977 as a researcher and was responsible for the dual program that partnered with The National Planning Council. In 1978 he was awarded a fellowship to study in France to complete his masters and Ph.D at Sorbonne University in Paris and was awarded his Ph.D in 1984. His Ph.D in Political Science and International Relations received the highest honors with a specialization in Arab Western Relations. After his return to the Ministry of Planning he joined The University of Jordan as a member of the faculty in Political Science. During his presence at the University of Jordan he was appointed Assistant Dean for Administrative Matters and was also appointed as Chairman of the Political Science for multiple terms. He was appointed Dean of the College of Social Sciences and founding Dean of Prince Hussein School of International Studies. In the following years he was a visiting professor at universities in Jordan and a member of the faculty at Prince Hussein School of International Studies. He was reappointed as Dean of Prince Hussein School of International Studies where he currently serves as Dean.

Professor Abdullah Nagrash's publications encompass national, regional and international research. He was also the author of a weekly column for ten years at Al Rai and Al Dustoor newspapers where he is fluent in Arabic, English and French. He participated in numerous international, regional and domestic conferences. He is a member of many academic and administrative committees in the public and private sectors in Jordan. An example is the founding committee of The Institute of Diplomacy and the committee for establishment of Bait Al Hikmeh at Al Albait University. He was also a contributing member to restructuring colleges within The University of Jordan. He was also a Board Member of The national Human Rights center for four consecutive years. He is a political activist for political rights on the domestic and regional level particularly in human rights.
